Summary of Topic:

What do I do?

Main Curriculum Tie:

Health science career exploration, academic foundations and communication.

Required Materials for Lesson:

Printout of health science careers on hard stock and cut into individual careers.

Background for Teacher:

Knowledge of health science careers. You can get printable lists of careers by searching the internet or on the NDE Health Sciences Website: Career Pathways and Specialties.

Student Prior Knowledge:

Intended Learning Outcome:

Do a quick internet search to find a job description of the career you "draw" and then share it with the class.

Instructional Procedure:

- Have career list cut out and ready to draw out of a bucket/sack.
- Each student "draws" a career and then is given 15-20 minutes to find a job description of that career on the internet.
- Each student shares with the class their findings.

How to Measure Outcome:

Give credit for getting the job search done and also having a correct job description. This could be done at the beginning of the year so students could later choose one of the careers to do in-depth research and shadow.
