# PARENTAL REVOCATION OF CONSENT FOR CONTINUED PROVISION OF SPECIAL EDUCATION AND RELATED SERVICES 

(92 NAC 51-009.08B4)

to receive special education and related services. Therefore, I am revoking consent for the continued provision of special education and related services.

By revoking consent, I understand that the school district:

1. May not continue to provide special education and related services to the child, but must provide prior written notice before ceasing the provision of special education and related services. (92 NAC 51009.08B4a)
2. May not use the Mediation or Due Process procedures in order to obtain agreement or a ruling that the services may be provided to the child. (92 NAC 51-009.08B4b)
3. Will not be considered to be in violation of the requirement to make free appropriate public education available to the child because of the failure to provide the child with further special education and related services. (92 NAC 51-009.08B4c)
4. Is not required to convene an Individualized Education Program (IEP) Team meeting or develop an IEP for the child for further provision of special education and related services. (92 NAC 51-009.08B4d)
5. Will no longer provide services to your child as of the date the school district provides written notice.
6. Is not required to amend the child's education records to remove any references to the child's receipt of special education and related services because of the revocation of consent. (92 NAC 51-003.09)
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
