### Classroom activity for Input and Output

## INPUT STATION 1

### Digital Camera

Read the Camera User Manual and learn how to do the following:


1. Take a picture (actually take three pictures).
2. Download the pictures to the Instructor PC.
3. Run a slide show on the PC.



## OUTPUT STATION 1 Printer

By reviewing the printer manual, learn how to do the following:

1. Load the paper.
2. Manually feed paper (print document on letterhead paper).
3. Identify where the toner is located, remove toner, and shake it gently 2 times.
4. Identify areas where you would check for a paper jam.
5. Change the printer settings on the PC to print a watermark that says, "Who are You?"
6. Reboot the computer when done.



## INPUT & OUTPUT STATION 2 Microphone & Headphones

Read about Sound  
Recorder in Windows Help

1. Record each person's voice.
2. Save each recording with its own file name (name of student).
3. Experiment with the features of sound recorder (i.e., Use some of the options under the "Effects" menu). Save those changed files under a new name.
