

Instructions: State Substitute Teaching Permit Initial & Renewal for Nebraska Certification

The State Substitute Teaching Permit is valid for five (5) years and authorizes teaching in any subject at any level with unlimited number of days of teaching. However, not more than ninety (90) days may be taught in the same assignment (same class or subject to the same students).
