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SCOPE

The Nebraska Education Profile (NEP) Information collection is used to collect district information and graduation requirement information for Nebraska school districts. This information will be displayed on the Nebraska Education Profile (NEP) website for the following school year. This collection is part of the Consolidated Data Collection (CDC).

All Public Districts must report this data.

INSTRUCTIONS

Access

- 1. Log into the NDE Portal at <u>https://portal.education.ne.gov/</u>
- 2. Click on the blue Data Collections tab



3. Click on the Consolidated Data Collection (CDC) link



Note: Accessing the Nebraska Education Profile (NEP) Information collection requires a Consolidated Data Collection (CDC) activation code – General, All or Approver User Type. If you do not have the Consolidated Data Collection (CDC) in Data Collections, you will need to obtain an activation code from your District Admin.

Navigate

Upon entering the collection, you will see

- 1. The Title
- 2. A Main Menu list of options
- 3. The District Information section to complete
- 4. The School information section to update
- 5. A Summary Report button, and
- 6. The Submit/Approve section (Only Approver user types will see the Approve button)



Main Menu options

Contact Us - Lists NDE contacts to call or email if you have questions while completing the report.

Click for Instructions - Opens this document.

Other Main Menu options seen throughout the collection include:

Logout - Closes the current tab you are working on and returns you to the NDE Portal.

NEP Main Pg - Returns you to the Nebraska Education Profile (NEP) main page.

CDC Main Pg - Takes you back to the Consolidated Data Collections main page.

Graduation Requirements

The Graduation Requirements page requests information about high school graduation requirements. There are separate sections for Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies, and Science.

Again, data will be prepopulated from the previous year, if available. Review the data and ensure the number of years and required subjects for high school graduation are correct for each section. This data will appear on the Nebraska Education Profile (NEP) website as part of the district graduation requirements.

You may edit these sections as needed, or, if no changes need to be made, click **Save Data** or **Save Data and Close** to return to the Nebraska Education Profile (NEP) Information collection main page.

You can also print the page by clicking the **Print Page** button.

Approve

After the data has been submitted and there are no further edits needed, the collection is ready for approval. If the school district's APPROVER is satisfied with the collection, they click the **APPROVE** button to officially submit the data in the collection to the NDE.

Note: Only one person in the district can be assigned the APPROVER role for the Consolidated Data Collection (CDC), giving access to the **APPROVE** button. The APPROVER can also Submit collections if need be and is typically also the District Superintendent.

Note: Once the data has been approved, the data cannot be edited by anyone with access to the collection, even the Approver. If additional editing is needed, the district will have to contact NDE to request re-opening of the collection.

Note:

Multiple Districts: If a user is responsible for more than one district, they will need to enter the appropriate activation codes for each district's Consolidated Data Collection (CDC). Once all activation codes have been entered, changing districts is done from within the Consolidated Data Collection (CDC) by clicking on the "Change Districts", then "Submit" button on the left hand side of the screen. This will take you to a screen allowing you to change districts.
