This system combines final financial reporting for SPED Birth to Age Five, SPED School Age and SPED Transportation.

Data Submission:

- Data requested must be submitted through the NDE Portal, on the ILCD 3.0 website.
- Select the “Accountability” tab from the top of the page.
- Select “Indicator 11” from the sub menu
- Complete the requested information (A-E except letter D)
- Click “Save” and “Submit”

Data Submission:

- Data requested must be submitted through the NDE Portal, on the ILCD 3.0 website.
- Select the “Accountability” tab from the top of the page.
- Select “Indicator 12” from the sub menu
- Complete line D. Data for lines A-C are imported from ADVISER.
- Click “Save” and “Submit”
