reVISION is a strategic approach for Nebraska schools to analyze their current Career and Technical Education system and make adjustments to more effectively prepare students for college and careers.

Why reVISION?

reVISION provides a unique opportunity to bring understanding, new energy, and commitment to Career and Technical Education as a vital education, workforce, and economic development strategy.

FIRST MEETING

Review and assess current career and technical education programs; collaborate with NE CTE staff, CTE staff, school counselors, administrators, and Departments of Labor & Economic Development staff to review and analyze data and identify areas for improvement

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT MEETING

Share key information & gather feedback from community stakeholders

SECOND MEETING

Review key information & feedback to initiate Action Plan development

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

Individualized support by NCE staff to develop and finalize a 3-5 year reVISION Action Plan
