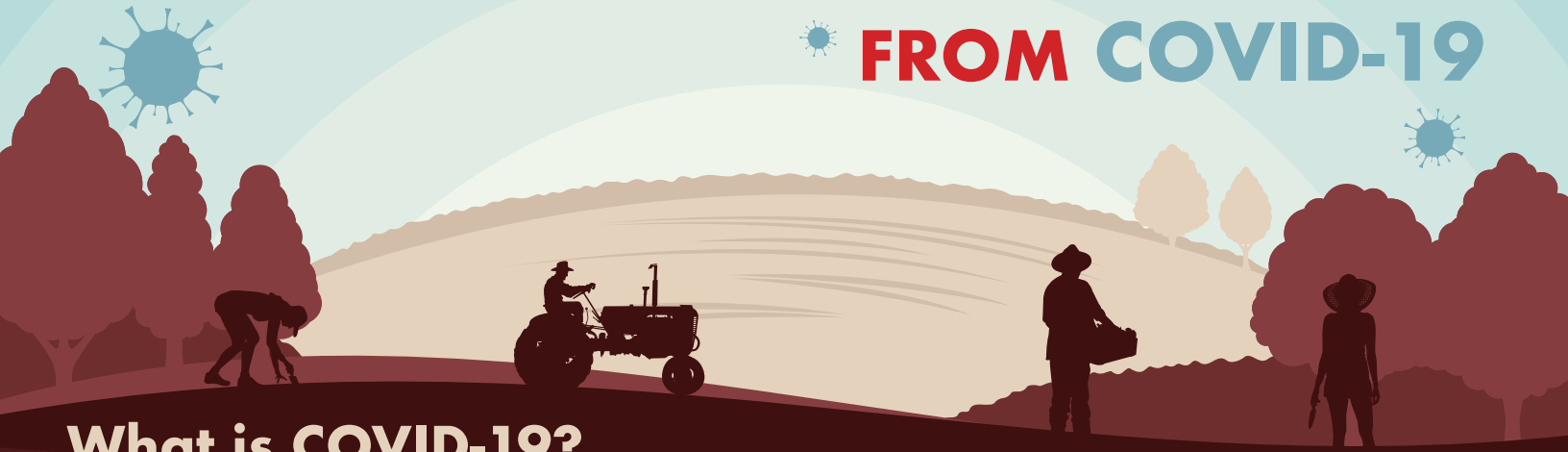


PROTECTING AGRICULTURAL WORKERS FROM COVID-19

How does COVID-19 spread?

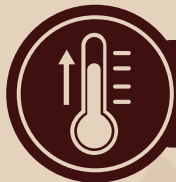
Close Personal Contact

Fever
(above 100.4 °F/38°C)



Dry Cough



Difficulty Breathing

Other symptoms include: Fatigue and body aches.
Note: Symptoms may vary from person to person.



Who is most likely to become seriously ill from COVID-19?

- People with medical conditions, such as:
 - Heart disease
 - Diabetes
 - Respiratory disease



When do symptoms appear?

Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after being infected. However, you can infect others before you show any symptoms.
