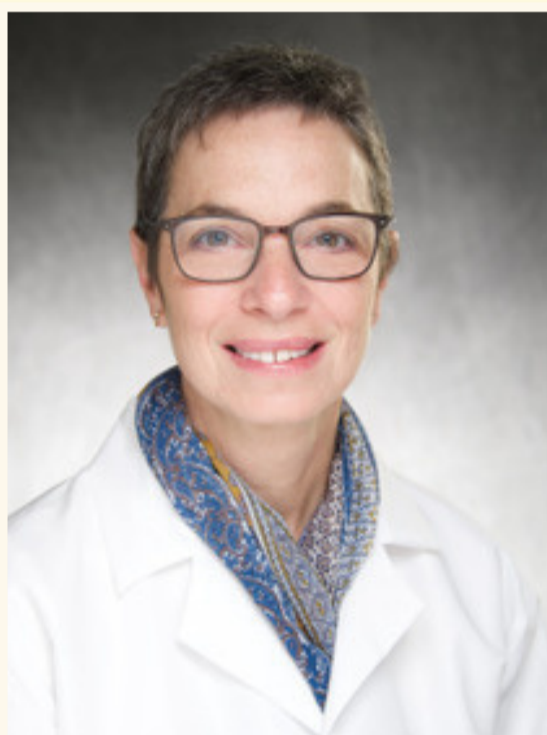

He is Dean of the College of Public Health at the University of Nebraska Medical Center (UNMC) and a former Assistant Surgeon General with the US Public Health Service. Dean Khan is committed to measuring the impact of the College's educational programs and initiatives and has established a goal to make Nebraska the healthiest and most equitable state in the Union. Dr. Khan's professional career has focused on health security, global health, and emerging infectious diseases. He completed a 23-year career as a senior director at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), which he joined as a disease detective, and where he led numerous high profile domestic and international public health responses.

She is an Occupational and Environmental Medicine Physician and a clinical assistant professor at the University of Iowa. She has prior experience as a surgeon, as well as the medical director for Healthcare Services at the Iowa Department of Public Health, where she served as Medical Director for the Iowa Disaster/Terrorism Preparedness Program. She has a current focus on the health and wellbeing of immigrant, migrant and refugee populations, including the migrant and seasonal farmworker populations. Over the past year she has worked with Proteus, a HRSA-funded FQHC, to help lead the pandemic mitigation response for COVID-19 for the MSFWs in Iowa.

He is the President of Farmworker Justice in Washington D.C., a national organization that empowers farmworkers to improve their wages, working conditions, occupational safety, health, immigration policy and access to justice. Mr. Goldstein's activities include advocacy in administrative agencies and Congress, building coalitions, advising grassroots organizations, litigating high-impact cases against employers and government, training of legal professionals, and shaping public opinion through publications and the media. He represents Farmworker Justice on the National Hispanic Leadership Agenda and is a co-founder and Board member of the Equitable Food Initiative, an innovative corporate social responsibility project.
