

Course Offerings that meet the Work-Based Learning Supplemental Endorsement Requirement

Rule 24 states that the Work-Based Learning Endorsement is a Supplemental Endorsement. Persons with this endorsement may coordinate, teach, and supervise programs of instruction that develop career and life skills. The endorsement requires a minimum of three (3) semester hours in the coordination and supervision of work-based learning. In addition, the endorsement is available only to those who have either (A) 1,000 verified hours of paid work experience, or (B) at least 300 hours of supervised work experience under the direction of the college or university recommending the endorsement.

Chadron State College Work-Based Learning endorsement requires:

CTE 438/538 Coordination Techniques/Work-Based Learning plus CTE 390 or 690 that includes 300 hours of supervised work experience or 1000 verified hours volunteer, internship, or paid work experience.
