

New Federal Requirements Beginning February 7, 2022

Changes apply to:

- **New CDL Licenses**
 - Entry-level driver training includes training for individuals applying for a Class A or Class B CDL for the first time.
- **Upgrading CDL Licenses**
 - Upgrading a Class B to a Class A CDL, or applying for a school bus (S), passenger (P), or hazardous materials (H) endorsement for the first time.

- **What is Entry-Level Driver Training:**
 - Required training to be taken by entry level drivers prior to taking the CDL skills test. Training must be taken with a registered trainer.
