



#### Steps in the Process of Instruction

- High Expectations for All (Know ALDs and PLDs)
- Engage Students with interesting tasks
- Observe what students can do
- Scaffold/Support with word banks, linguistic frames
- Reflect and Adapt monitor progress and plan accordingly
