

Nebraska School Safety



EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLANNING (EOP)

Purpose: The purpose of this two-day training is to help create, modify, or update your school's Emergency Operations Plan. The training will assist schools to prevent, prepare, respond, and recover from a threat, hazard, or incident.

How: The virtual presentation of this training has shown an increased participation by the community partners throughout the state. Some school share the same law enforcement officer, the same emergency manager, and the same fire/rescue person. Allowing the virtual approach, these members of your team can enter and move within other school safety teams in the breakout rooms during this training.

Why: Analysis of school safety plans statewide indicated support was needed to ensure schools had a comprehensive, working, living document to guide schools and emergency responders before, during, and after an emergency incident or event.

It is necessary for schools and emergency responders to plan together and build stronger relationships for responses to be protective of students and staff, respond efficiently, and to return the school back to a learning environment as quickly as possible.

This is a working training where concepts and best practices are shared. You and your safety team will have time throughout the 2 days to work on your current Emergency Operations Plan.

Who: School Safety Team
(Up to 10 members*)

*Includes:

- Law Enforcement Officer
- Local Emergency Manager
- Fire/Rescue Person

Up to 6 stipends available for each school district for non-contract personnel attending both days. District Sub reimbursement is also available. For the benefit of the district, personnel must attend both days.
