

DEFINING THE TERMS:



Community: The Nebraska town or city where the Afterschool/Summer program takes place.

District: School district; the majority of ESSER allocations were awarded to school districts to build off of the strong foundation provided by Nebraska public schools.

Program: The team or organization that manages overarching administrative and programmatic duties of ELOs. Programs might oversee one or more sites.


Site: The school or community location of a program. Some programs only have one site, some have several.

Expanded Learning Opportunities (ELO): Hands-on, engaging learning opportunities for students outside of the regular school day.


Incubator: Newly developing program/site and/or program/site that does not receive 21st Century Community Learning Center funds.

Accelerator: Established program/site that receives 21st Century Community Learning Center funds in addition to ESSER funding.
