OVERVIEW

The resources that will be used to engage students in this program will include KCLC informing students of this opportunity during class registration. Students deciding to participate in this program will have a t-shirt provided by KCLC which is used to help identify students when leaving school grounds, the purchase of boots to ensure rider safety, curriculum provided by County Extension service, crafting projects overseen by Ms. Bruce that relate to horses or products used for horses (like horseshoes). While riding horses, KCLC students will be learning proper horseriding techniques, guest speakers/presenters will come to Christine's Horse Riding to demonstrate or explain horse care, hoof care, and leatherwork/saddlery. The culminating event will be students presenting a horse show to parents and family at the Buffalo County Fairgrounds' arena which will involve students/horse navigating an obstacle course and being judged by a certified horse judge. Students will receive a score and a participation ribbon.
