HOW TO DETERMINE QUALIFYING ARRIVAL DATES

Remember the child/or youth needs to move for economic necessity/across school district lines for an agriculture or non-ag job within 36 months of when the MAW is established with the MAW.

Tips and Ideas

Locating an OSY who has moved

- When recruiting, try to get the phone number of a close relative or friend that does not move so you can call them to locate the youth if they move.
- When feasible keep a list of youth that do not qualify.
- If the youth approaches you or you find them again, you can shorten the interview by targeting the area of ineligibility from the last interview.

Obtaining referrals

- Make sure to ask OSY for referrals of other possible qualifying youth in the area.

WHAT IS A QUALIFYING MOVE?

1. made due to economic necessity; *and*
2. from one residence to another residence; *and*
3. from one school district to another school district.*



*In a State that is comprised of a single school district, a move qualifies if it is from one administrative area to another within the district. In addition, in a school district of more than 15,000 square miles, a move qualifies if it is over a distance of 20 miles or more to a temporary residence.

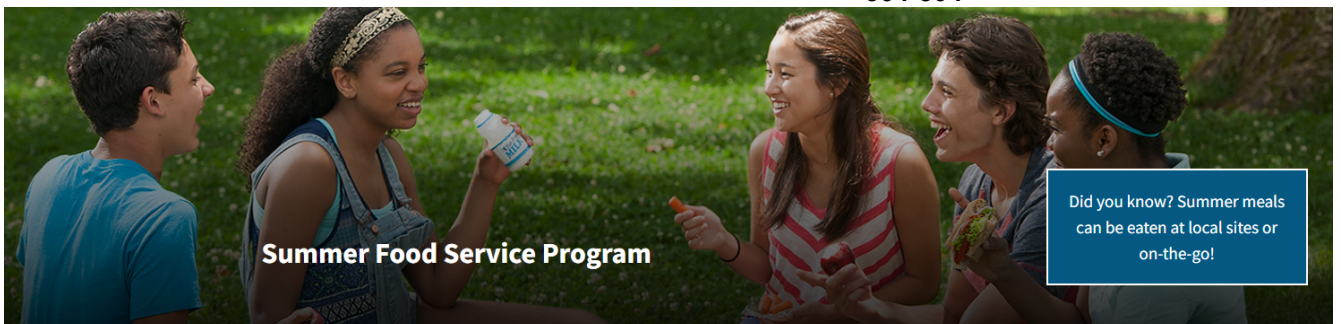

OpenSky and Nebraska Appleseed said there need to be policies to make our economy more inclusive.

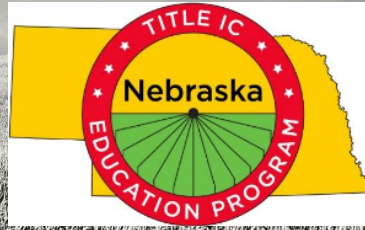
For example, they mentioned recognizing more professional licenses from foreign countries.
