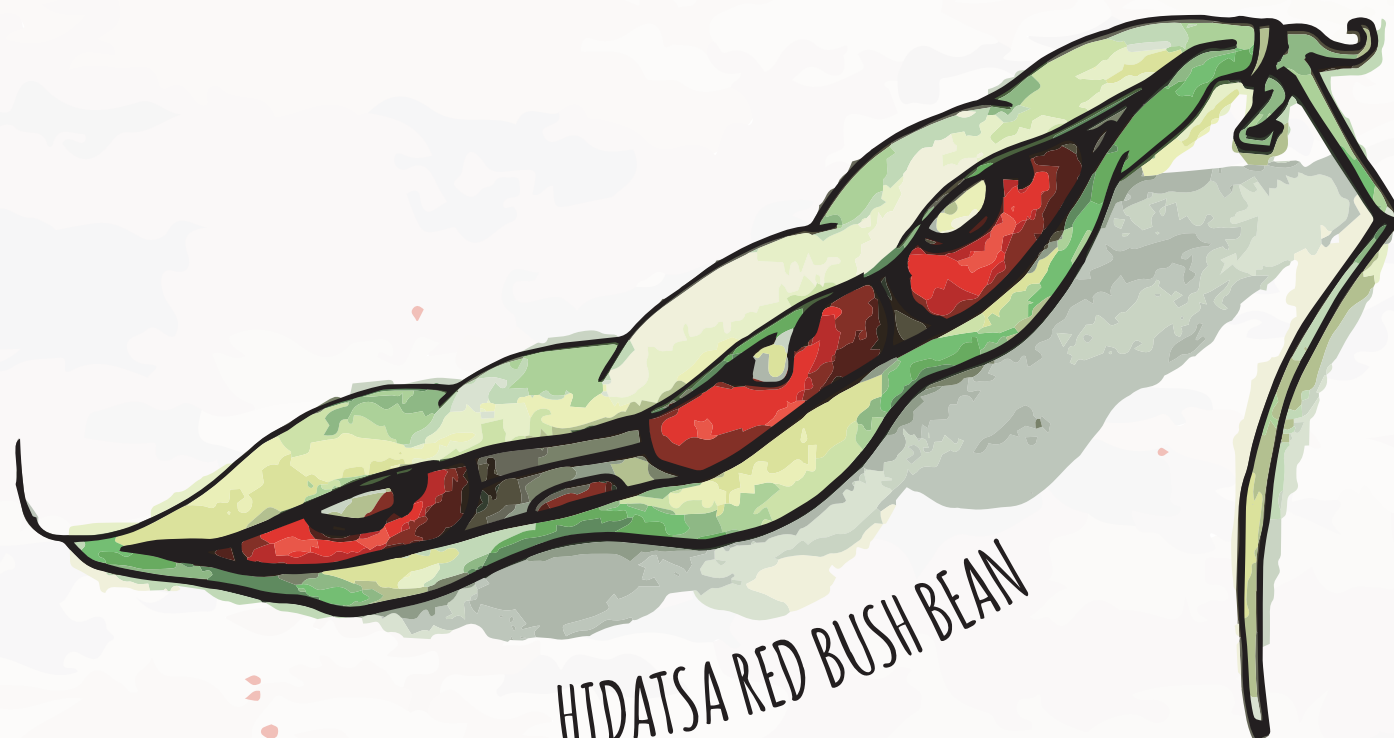
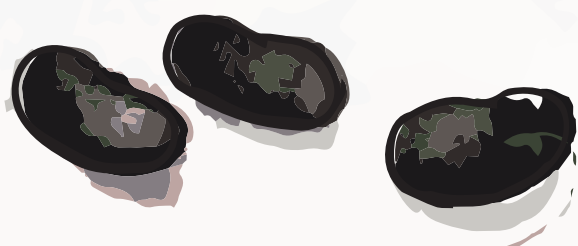

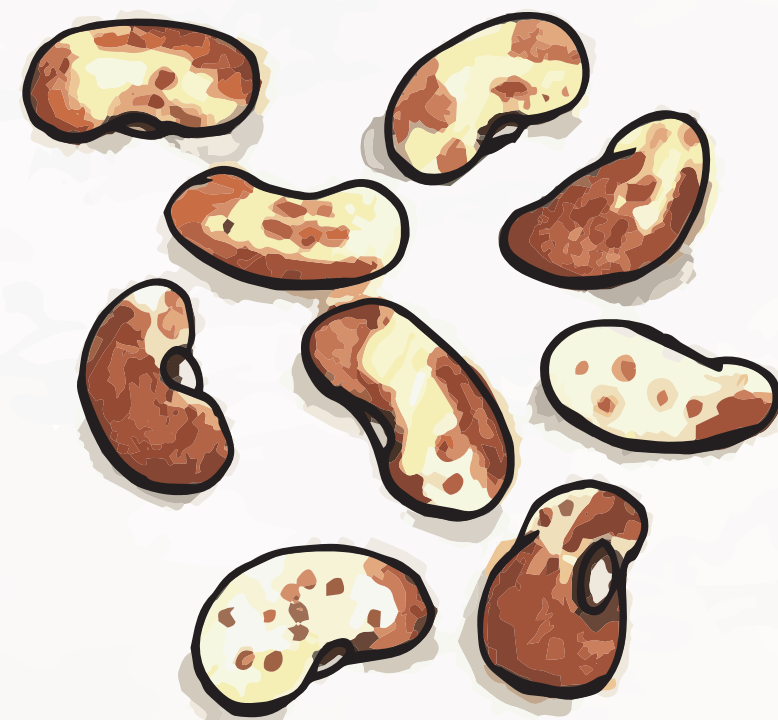


HIDATSA RED BUSH BEAN

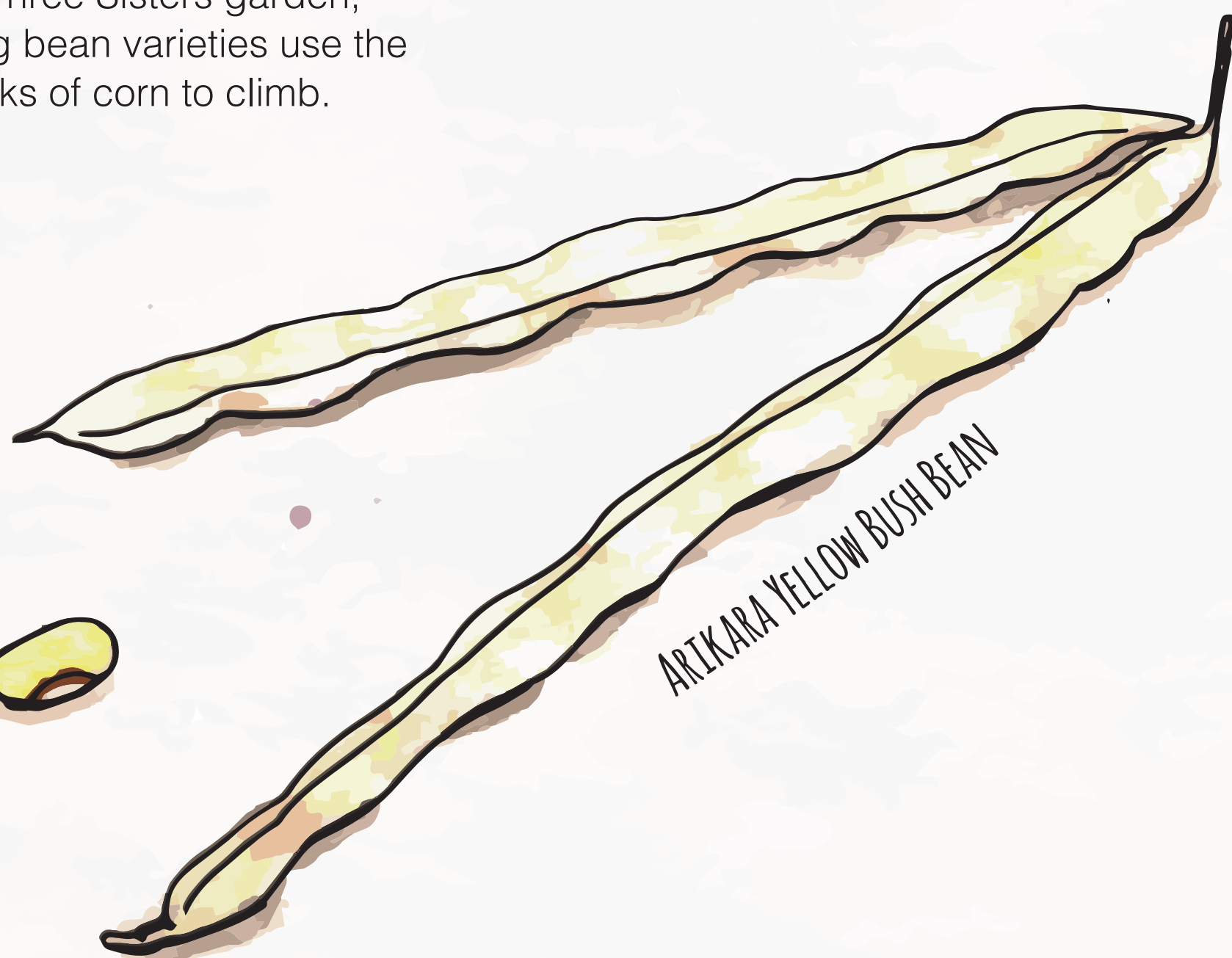
In a Three Sisters garden, climbing bean varieties use the stalks of corn to climb.

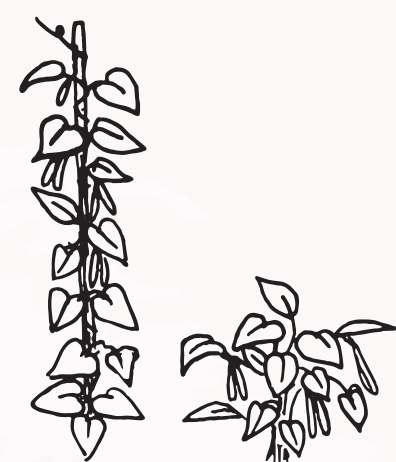


ARTKARA YELLOW BUSH BEAN

Pole beans grow as climbing vines that may reach 10-15 feet tall and require a trellis or staking. Bush beans grow compactly (reaching about two-feet tall) and do not require extra support.
