FOREWORD

Nebraska statute 79-703 requires that the State Board of Education establish standards for the approval and accreditation of Nebraska schools and further, that the Commissioner of Education appoint an accreditation committee which “shall be responsible for: (a) recommending appropriate standards and policies with respect to the accreditation and classification of schools; and (b) making recommendations annually to the Commissioner relative to the accreditation and classification of individual schools.”

This report is presented to the State Accreditation Committee for review and consideration in fulfilling the responsibilities prescribed in statute. The report provides the status of currently accredited schools, based upon compliance with Rule 10 (*Regulations and Procedures for the Accreditation of Schools*). It also contains other support information related to school status and accreditation. This report will serve as the basis for State Accreditation Committee action at the meeting of May 16, 2023.

State Accreditation Committee
Meeting Minutes
January 19, 2023

The Nebraska State Accreditation Committee met via Zoom on January 19, 2023. Travis Miller, Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., declared a quorum present, and established the legality of the meeting. Members present were the following: LeeAnn Amm, Wayne Brown, Susan Christopherson, Susanne Cramer, Brad Dirksen, Josie Floyd, Dale Fornander, Jeff Ganz, Dale Hafer, Stacie Hardy, Pat Hoehner, Vickie Kauffold, Dan Koenig, Travis Miller, Dan Schnoes, Bess Scott and Tiffanie Welte.

Members absent: Mitch Kubicek, Marco Pedroza, and Sarah Salem.

NDE staff members participating in all or some of the Zoom meeting were the following: Deputy Commissioner Deb Frison, Shirley Vargas, Micki Charf, Todd Wolverton and Sandra Suiter.

Meeting Opening

Travis Miller reviewed with members the purpose of Rule 10 (equity of opportunity, quality of learning, and accountability) and the Committee's role and responsibility. After brief introductions, Travis Miller asked for approval of the May 17, 2022, minutes. Josie Floyd moved to approve the minutes and Dan Schnoes seconded the motion.

Approval carried 17-0 with 3 absent.

Members were asked to approve the Agenda for the January 19, 2023, meeting. Dale Fornander moved to accept the Agenda and Pat Hoehner seconded the motion.

The January 19, 2023, Agenda was approved by a unanimous vote of the Committee.

State Accreditation Committee Handbook

Micki Charf reviewed the SAC Handbook outlining committee members' responsibilities, composition of current members, meeting logistics, and current vacancies. There are currently 20 members and 3 vacancies. Micki will be forwarding the membership application to committee members for their input on new member nominations.

Review of Past State Accreditation Committee Meetings

Micki Charf highlighted some key points from past meetings: E-learning, the Rule 10 Revision Project and ESSA Updates.

Technical Amendment Updates – Brad Dirksen

Brad Dirksen gave an overview of proposed revisions to Rule 10 and Rule 14. The purpose of the proposed revisions is to incorporate 79-724 (American Citizenship) and 79-725 (Character Education) into rules to ensure compliance with 79-727 (Rules and regulations; State Department of Education; duties.) Additionally, edits were made to reduce redundancy with Nebraska Revised State Statutes (e.g., the definition of "teach" now reflects a reference to the statutory definition), elimination of appendix documents, and other minor edits (e.g., replace "shall" with "must").

A Public Hearing will be held January 31, 2023 at 9:00 a.m., held via zoom.

AQuESTT Presentation: Accountability and School Supports

Shirley Vargas presented an overview of AQuESTT - A Quality Education System for Today and Tomorrow: A system of accountability and support.

An accountability system is required based on state and federal mandates to:

Set standards for all schools; ensure responsible use of taxpayer investment & focus funds for improvement; expose and close achievement gaps among student groups; and create a framework for school improvement.

AQuESTT is made up of classifications along with a framework for improvement. The accountability system is comprised of a set of indicators which is a way to measure student achievement; or elements perceived to influence those gains. Information was shared on the 2022 Classifications, 2022 Designations and TSI/ATSI Distribution along with available resources.

2022-23 Compliance Data Review

Micki Charf discussed mandatory requirements for compliance and how school compliance is monitored: assurance statements, data reporting, and compliance visits. Last year we began messaging the importance of self-reporting on the assurance statements. Micki also shared a snapshot of a 4 year data trend on unmet regulations.

Nebraska Continuous Improvement

-Micki Charf talked about the Coherence Project and the collaboration between Accreditation and NeMTSS which has focused on identifying similarities between the 2012 Nebraska Framework and the NeMTSS problem solving model. The department has been working on revised resources for continuous improvement including the CNA, the Nebraska Perceptual Survey, and their connection to AQuESTT. The framework for these revised processes, procedures and materials developed for Nebraska Continuous Improvement will become available for implementation on January 31, 2023.

-Shirley Vargas talked more in-depth about the CNA and committee members were asked to participate in a simulation activity mimicking what a team would do when they are engaging with the CNA.

-Sandra Suiter highlighted some of the new materials developed by the NDE to help schools with continuous improvement. Hanover Research developed a Data Literacy Workbook which schools are encouraged to use as a teaching and orientation tool for staff. Some additional materials include both Host School System & External Lead Responsibilities handbooks.

Rule 10 Discussion

Guided group discussion around:

- Which regulations do you feel ensure equitable learning opportunities for Nebraska students?
- Which regulations are burdensome and / or difficult to meet?

SCHOOL SYSTEMS APPROVED FOR CONTINUED ACCREDITATION

Staff Recommendation: It is recommended that the following Class II-Class V, Special Purpose, and Nonpublic school systems, be recommended to the State Board of Education for continued accreditation in 2023-24.

Rationale: The schools listed are found to be operating in compliance with Rule 10. This is based on information submitted on their Assurance Statements and, in some instances, gathered on Rule 10 visits to the schools. The schools that listed “areas of non-compliance” on the Assurance Statement submitted a correction of the violations to the Department of Education by the February 1 due date, as provided in Rule 10, and, therefore, are considered in compliance for the full school year.

(Any schools dissolving, merging, or unifying for the 2023-24 school year will be accredited under the new name.)

CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT IN 2022-23
(Regulation 10-009.01A)

Accredited schools are required to conduct a continuous school improvement process focused on the improvement of student learning. Schools use procedures outlined in *The Nebraska Framework for School Improvement* or developed by Cognia, although a school may use any continuous improvement process that includes the following activities at least once in each five years:

1. Review and update of a mission statement. (009.01A1)
2. Collection and analysis of data about student performance, demographics, learning climate, and former high school students. (009.01A2)
3. Selection of improvement goals. At least one goal is directed toward improvement of student performance. (009.01A3)
4. Development and implementation of a plan which includes procedures, strategies, or actions to achieve goals. (009.01A4)
5. Evaluation of progress toward improvement goals. (009.01A5)
6. Incorporation of multicultural education. (009.01A6)
7. An external team visit. (009.01A7)

IMPLEMENTATION OF ACCREDITATION IN NEBRASKA

Rule 10 (*Regulations and Procedures for the Accreditation of Schools*) establishes minimum requirements for the legal operation of all public schools in Nebraska and those nonpublic schools that elect to operate as accredited rather than approved. The Rule establishes equality of opportunity for all students, but it also provides schools flexibility in how they may meet the requirements. While all teachers, for example must be certificated, schools are afforded some latitude in matching assignments and endorsements. Schools may exercise a number of options in offering high school courses ranging from cooperative arrangements with other schools or agencies to synchronous and asynchronous distance education agreements.

Beginning in the Fall of 2019 and upon direction from the Board, NDE staff began revising Rule 10. Revision processes included input from various offices at the agency that have a role in determining how teaching and learning occurs in schools. By the Spring of 2021, a three-rule structure for Approval, Accreditation, and Accountability was drafted and a public input survey deployed. The revision team began analyzing public input and ultimately, due to hardships created by the Covid-19 pandemic, the State Board of Education voted on September 2, 2021, to pause the revision process.

Throughout the school year, the Accreditation Office monitors regulations through the Assurance Statement report, Staff Personnel reporting, and data collections. When a school system is found to be out of compliance with a specific regulation, accreditation staff discusses needed corrective actions and works with the school towards compliance for the following school year. Rule 10 is clearly not a static document; it is, rather, responsive to a number of influences and events. Ultimately accreditation seeks to ensure equity of opportunity across the state for each Nebraska student. Nebraska schools continue to meet the requirements of accreditation set forth in Rule 10 and are to be applauded for their work in improving teaching and learning.

APPENDIX A

NEBRASKA STATUTE 79-703

79-703.

Public schools; education programs in state institutions that house juveniles; approval and accreditation standards; accreditation committee; duties; legislative intent.

(1) To ensure both equality of opportunity and quality of programs offered, all public schools in the state shall be required to meet quality and performance-based approval or accreditation standards as prescribed by the State Board of Education. The board shall establish a core curriculum standard, which shall include multicultural education and vocational education courses, for all public schools in the state. Accreditation and approval standards shall be designed to assure effective schooling and quality of instructional programs regardless of school size, wealth, or geographic location. Accreditation standards for school districts that are members of a learning community shall include participation in the community achievement plan for the learning community as approved by the board. Accreditation standards for education programs in state institutions under the supervision of the Department of Health and Human Services that house juveniles shall include an annual report to the State Board of Education by the superintendent of institutional schools. The board shall recognize and encourage the maximum use of cooperative programs and may provide for approval or accreditation of programs on a cooperative basis, including the sharing of administrative and instructional staff, between school districts for the purpose of meeting the approval and accreditation requirements established pursuant to this section and section [79-318](#).

(2) The Commissioner of Education shall appoint an accreditation committee which shall be representative of the educational institutions and agencies of the state and shall include as a member the director of admissions of the University of Nebraska.

(3) The accreditation committee shall be responsible for: (a) Recommending appropriate standards and policies with respect to the accreditation and classification of schools; and (b) making recommendations annually to the commissioner relative to the accreditation and classification of individual schools. No school shall be considered for accreditation status which has not first fulfilled all requirements for an approved school.

(4) All public schools in the state, including, but not limited to, schools operated by school districts and education programs in state institutions under the supervision of the Department of Health and Human Services that house juveniles, shall be accredited.

(5) It is the intent of the Legislature that all public school students shall have access to all educational services required of accredited schools. Such services may be provided through cooperative programs or alternative methods of delivery.
