Where Do I Start?

- Find out where your parents work (tally from enrollment forms)
- Speak at community meetings i.e. Rotary, Kiwanis, LincUP,
- Search business websites for mission statements or community outreach tabs &
- Build a program around their C.O. objectives (allo...lego roboticss & UPRR Grant...SkillsUSA)
- Cold calls
- The more community involvement you do, the more community members will call you, put yourself out there.
- Press releases are so important, they put you in the news and spotlight your program within your community
- Sometimes you have to "kiss a pig" and partnerships don't work out; We suggest a loose partnership agreement form
- Sometimes your partnerships are magical and grow
- Advocate w/senators, visit, send newspaper clippings, invite them to your program
- Find your connections....i.e. comm. partner spouses, your own spouse, teachers in the district, high school student and college student staff members
- Create an advisory team
- Ask the students in your program what they are interested in, after all it's their program.

NP afterschool program adds basic soccer class

The North Platte Public Schools Kids Klub afterschool program launched a soccer training workshop at Cody School on Thursday. Future Kids, a nonprofit organization from Omaha, will come to town for eight weeks on Thursdays and will teach every Kids Klub program location in the district. Graeme Eaglesham is the head coach and will teach the students basic soccer skills. "The initial mission was to provide high quality sports programs to underserved communities," Eaglesham said. "Over in Omaha, you have communities where kids in a family can't afford to join the elite-style programs. So I started Future Kids back in 2017 to try and combat that problem." Eaglesham and his friends had coached elite soccer teams in the Omaha area. "We didn't think it was right

Home is no place for state secrets

Classified document scandals have federal lawmakers in an uproar

WASHINGTON — Democrats responded with aggrieved fury when former President Donald Trump was found in possession of classified documents that should have been turned over to the government when he left office. Then disclosures that President Joe Biden also mishandled secret papers set loose a Republican "well, what about?" roar. Now, with another discovery of classified documents, this time at the home of Trump's vice president, Mike Pence, the partisan finger-pointing seems to be melting into a chorus of mortification from Democrats and Republicans. The highest U.S. secrets, it now appears, are not necessarily safe with the highest officials. Not when they're in the hands of Trump, who disdains the rules and customs of government, and not in the hands of Biden and Pence, who subscribe to them. "Obviously there's a systemic problem in the executive branch," said Sen. Marco Rubio of Florida, top Republican on the
