- ◆ **What's covered:** Routine vision care, eyeglasses
- ◆ **Available through:** Medicaid providers

- ◆ **Eligibility:** Family income up to 200% of the U.S. federal poverty guidelines, no insurance coverage for the services covered
- ◆ **What's covered:** Eye exams, eyeglasses
- ◆ **Available through:** Voucher-based care provided by participating VSP doctors
