

ParentNotices – Checklist and Timelines

TransACT’s ESSA ParentNotices Collection includes the document “ESSA Stakeholder Notifications, Checklist and Timelines”, which provides the statutory reference for each ESSA notification and notes whether it is required in the law, helpful for implementing compliance requirements, or allowable under ESSA. It also includes other important information.

04 Finding and Sending Notices

ParentNotices provides several ways to locate the notices you need and deliver them to parents.

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Teacher and Paraprofessional Qualifications


Title I, Section 1112(e)(1)(B) says, “. . . A school that receives funds under this part shall provide to each individual parent of a child who is a student in such school, with respect to such student –”

- Information on academic achievement and growth, if available, on the State’s academic assessments
- Timely notice that the student has been assigned, or has been taught for 4 or more consecutive weeks by, a teacher who does not meet state certification and licensure requirements
- This document in ParentNotices is TPQ-03 – Notification of Teacher Status
