The 2023 World Language Week Distinguished Scholar could be YOU!

The World Language Distinguished Scholar Award recognizes Nebraska students for their:

- Leadership in language learning
- commitment to language study
- appreciation for cultural diversity
- communicative competence

Each teacher can nominate one student per level for each language. For students learning the world language as a Foreign Language, the levels are as follows:

- Level I/ II (i.e., German 1, German 2)
- Level III/IV (i.e., French 3, or French 4)
- Level 5+ (i.e., Spanish 5, AP, IB, etc.)
- Heritage/native speaker of the language of study (i.e., Spanish for Spanish Speakers 1, 2, 3, etc. You can nominate one for each level your school defines in this category. For example, there are Spanish for Spanish Speakers 1, 2, and 3 in your school; nominate 1 for each of those levels)

Teachers will [nominate](#) students by December 15th. Nominated students must complete a [submission form](#) representing their ability and appreciation for language learning by January 15th. Awards will be announced during World Language Week, February 19th - 25th.
