



Since the launch of Step Up to Quality in 2014, the early childhood education field has continued to advance and evolve. Just as we encourage providers to seek out opportunities for improvement, our Step Up to Quality team has learned a great deal about what works about our process in addition to what could be enhanced.

For those reasons and more, it was time to formally update our process. Launching Step Up to Quality 2.0 was a main focus for us this past year. The improvements we made included earlier coaching opportunities, observations choices and expanded indicator options for a more personalized experience.

We want to thank the hundreds of providers who attended feedback sessions and filled out surveys, giving us first-hand insights on improvements they wanted to see. We are also grateful for the dozens of early childhood education professionals from various aspects of our profession, from nonprofits, advocacy organizations, universities and more, who played an integral role in updating our process.

Since our last report, 55 more programs — serving a collective 3,639 children — have actively participated in Step Up to Quality. Since the launch of the new rating system in March 2023, 13 programs have been rated, and 15 additional programs have requested a rating.

We're so proud of the 700+ child care providers enrolled across Nebraska who are committed to continuous quality improvement every day, ensuring an excellent experience for the children in their care.




Every Provider Counts
