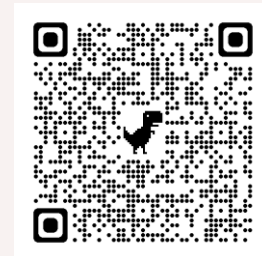
## What is involved in the Mini-Grant Process?
