# Title I Comparability

- Title I requirement to ensure that a district is providing comparable resources to Title I and non-Title I buildings.
  - Must have more than one building at the same grade span with 100 or more students
  - Must have at least 1 Title I building being served within that grade span.

# Title I Comparability continued

- Student / Instructional Staff Ratio  
or
- Students / Instructional Staff Salary Expenditures
- NDE's system uses the district's data from the Student and Staff Record System to do the calculations.

# Title I Comparability continued

- The system opens October 15<sup>th</sup> for viewing
  - Districts can look at the data as it's being loaded and finalized in the Staff Reporting System
- The Save Button is activated on November 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Include All (Staff & Students)
  - Exclude SPED Staff
  - Exclude EL Staff
  - Exclude SPED & EL Staff
- Report is due on or before November 15<sup>th</sup>

# Title I Comparability continued

- The Staff / pupil ratio in buildings served must be 10% or less than the ratio in non-Title I buildings served.
- Not being comparable = reduced allocation to the district
