Handwashing is a key part of preventing the spread of diseases in school. But how do you motivate students, especially younger ones, to wash their hands? The CDC recommends that schools "place visual cues such as handwashing posters, stickers, and other materials in highly visible areas throughout the school." Knowing this, the Children's Nebraska School Health Team conducted a statewide contest in the fall of 2023 for students to create a handwashing poster for schools, the winners of which would be published in a new infectious disease manual for schools. We wanted a way to get students involved, as they can then influence and motivate each other.

The poster contest was a success as over 200 students entered, primarily from 4th and 5th grade. A team of judges narrowed it down to 4 finalists. However, we had such a great turnout and so much wonderful artwork to choose from that we wanted to have a way to share more posters with more schools, early education centers, clinics, churches, and community organizations. That's why we made this poster pack, to share the talent in our state and to drive home the important message that handwashing is one of the best things kids can do to stay healthy and keep those around them healthy as well. We would like to sincerely thank the students, teachers, school nurses, parents, and guardians that helped this poster contest be successful and making this poster pack possible. We also thank our partner organizations, the Nebraska Department of Education, the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, Nebraska ICAP, and the Nebraska Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics for their help and support of this project.
