The Purpose of the Targeted Improvement Plan

- In building capacity for the MTSS framework and to support districts in an environment of strong local control, Nebraska has required each district to review their student data and establish a Targeted Improvement Plan (TIP) to show how continuous improvement efforts will impact the outcomes of students with disabilities.
- The TIP must be aligned to the overall general education improvement activities being implemented at the district to support improved outcomes of students with disabilities and their peers.





- Are Professional Development selections meaningful to staff and beneficial to the TIP target areas?








Evidence Based **Practice**

 - Quarterly Goal Setting Meetings with teachers with review & reflection
 - Informal Walk Through Data focused on implementation of strategy
 - Intervention Data bi-weekly conversations with general education
 - **NSCAS Proficiencies**
 - Data Dashboard for NSCAS
 - WORDS Project (UNL)








<u>Outcome Data ~ What data do we have that shows student progress?</u>

- NSCAS/MAP (Fall & Winter)
- Standards Based Reporting (Tier 1)
- Progress Monitoring Data (Tier 2 and Tier 3)

Focus Questions for Data Conversations

- What does the data show?
- What conclusions did the team draw?
- What clues in the outcome data suggest modifications needed in the plan?
- What changes are planned for the future?


