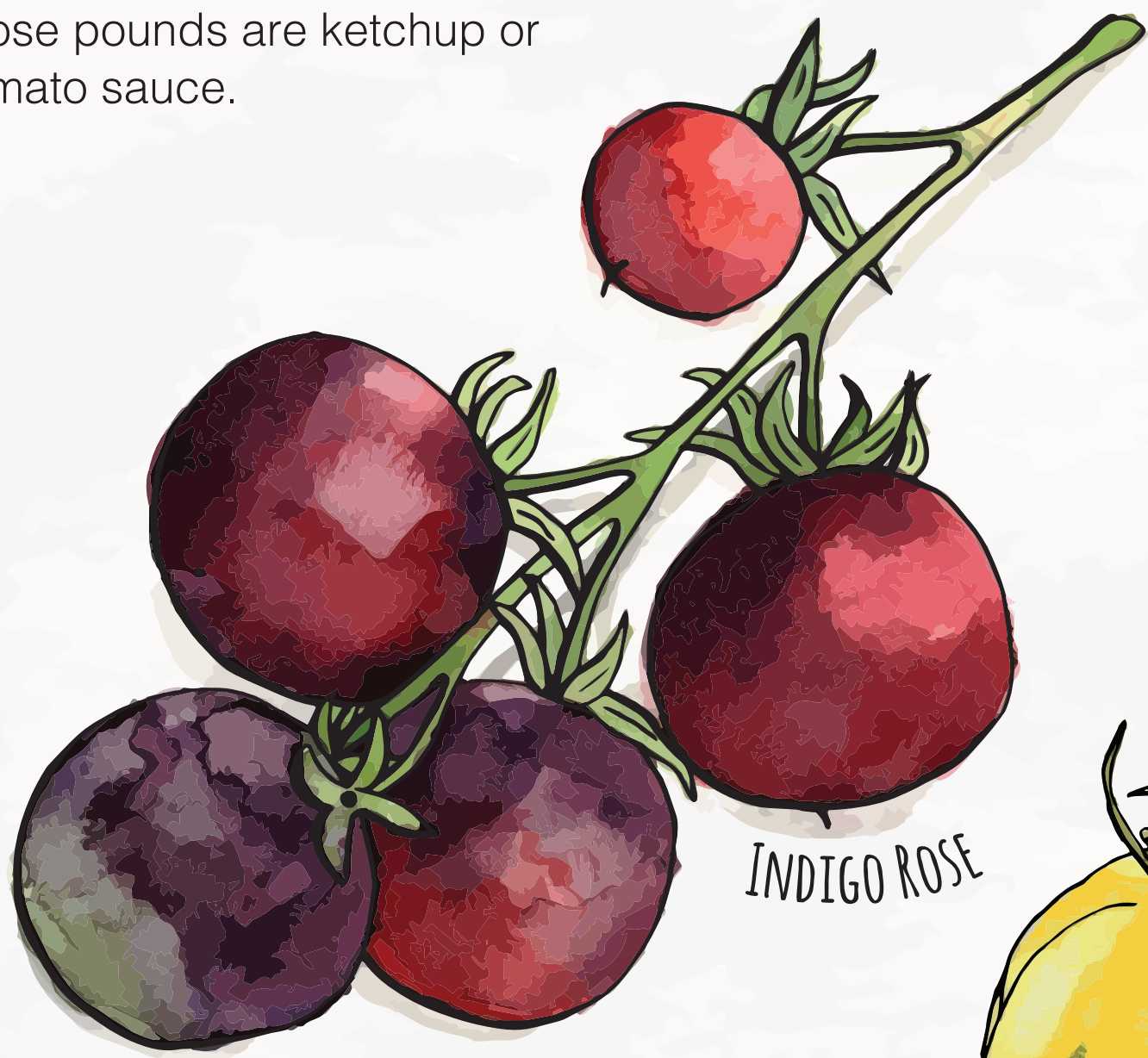

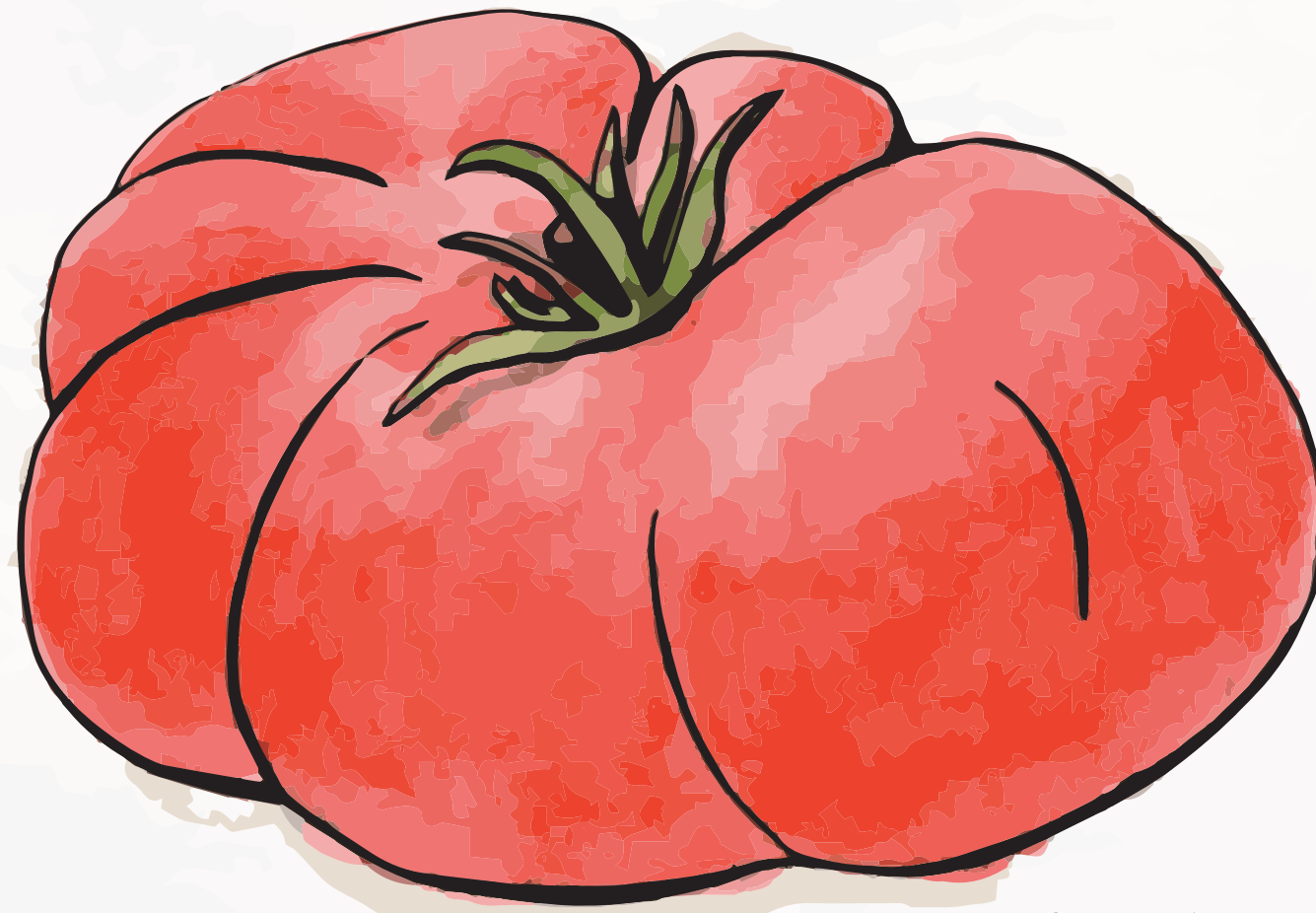
# TOMATOES

INDIGO ROSE



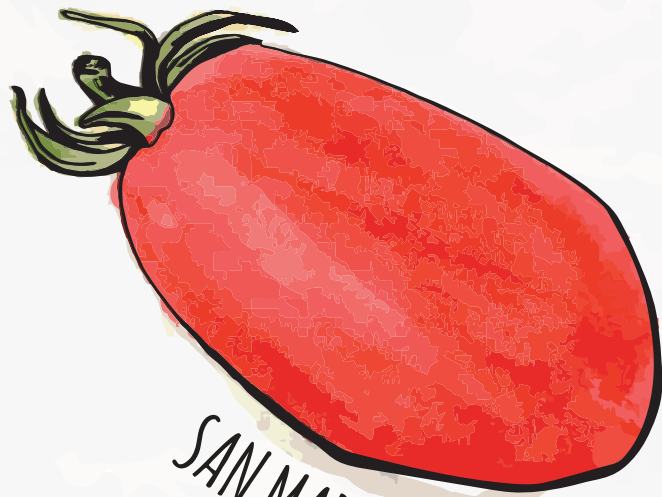

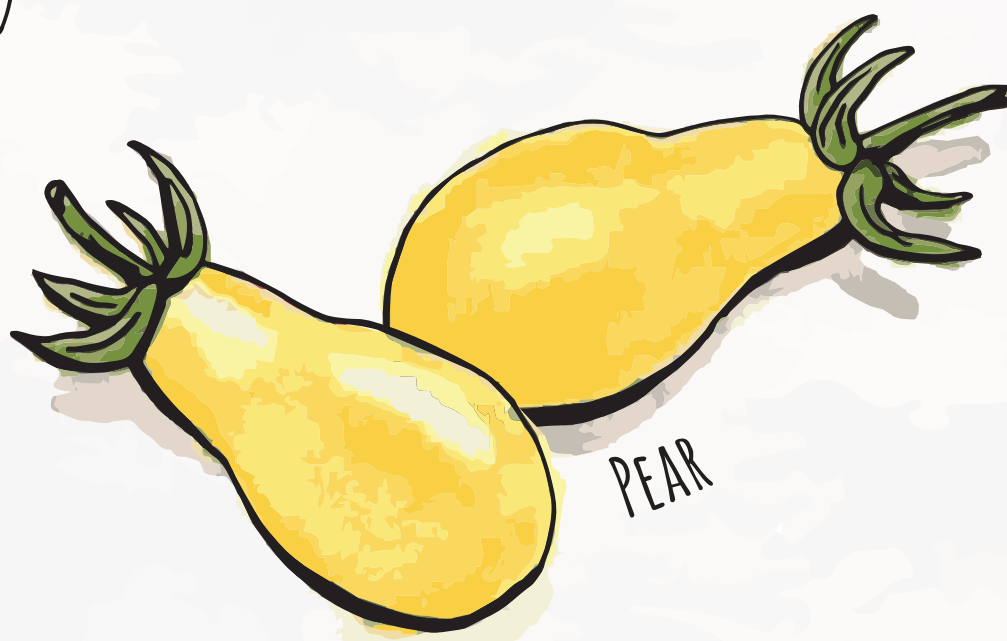

## FUN FACT -

There are over 25,000 varieties of tomatoes. Their sizes range from as small as a blueberry to as large as cantaloupe, and come in every color of the rainbow - including white and deep indigo blue.

## "BUZZ" - WORTHY FACT -

Tomato flowers need to be pollinated to produce a tomato fruit. The buzzing of bees and other insects searching for nectar, along with the wind, creates vibration in the tomato flower. This causes pollen to fall onto another flower, which then produces a tomato.
