A guide to the

Nebraska Special Education Service Provider Application

The Nebraska Department of Education Service Provider application was established to allow Nebraska Local Education Agencies (LEAs) to identify contracted providers who will provide IDEA allowable related services to students on Individual Education Plans (IEP's). The application requirements are listed in Nebraska Title 92 NAC Chapter 51, 013 Contracted Programs. The NDE approved rates are to be used in contracts between the provider and the LEA, not the Nebraska Department of Education (NDE).

The school district or approved cooperative will be allowed a forty-five (45) calendar day grace period when entering contracts with programs not provisionally approved by the Nebraska Department of Education. Within this forty-five-day grace period a school district or approved cooperative is responsible for notifying the program of the application and approval requirements of the Nebraska Department of Education. The application to provide services must be completed each year. The application is opened in late May and closes annually on October 15th.

The contract of services shall include at minimum the following:

A description of the services to be provided.

The names of children to be served.

A cost schedule for the services.

The NDE service code and agency code for the services provided.

A few notes for applications:

Setting an annual rate:

The Nebraska Department of Education, Office of Special Education establishes rates for each one-to-one service on an annual basis. NDE does not set a classroom/program rate, as each classroom or program is different. Classroom and program rates are calculated on the average per pupil cost (program per pupil cost) of the service agency of the preceding year or the cost as agreed upon pursuant to the contract to the agency providing the educational program for each child with a disability. A provider may request a rate higher than the state established one-to-one service rate. The provider may also request a rate lower than the state established rate. If the rate is higher that the state established rate, a cost allocation will need to be submitted with the rate request.

Service providers who request reimbursable rates <u>exceeding</u> NDE established rates shall submit, on forms provided by the Nebraska Department of Education, the following:

Personnel and their qualifications.

A cost schedule for services.

A written description of services.

Separation of sectarian educational costs and non-sectarian educational costs, if applicable.

Separation of the cost of residential care costs from the cost of the educational program, if applicable.

Documentation of conformance with building codes and safety requirements, if applicable; and

For Educational Service Units, a final report of expenditures which is due within 45 days after the service provider's fiscal year end.

Service providers who request reimbursable rates at or below NDE established rates shall submit, electronically via the NDE website to the Nebraska Department of Education, the following:

Personnel and their qualifications.

A cost schedule for services.

A written description of services; and

Documentation of conformance with building codes and safety requirements, if applicable.

Persons who do not need an approved rate:

District-owned teachers who provide extended school year (ESY) services.

Sign language interpreters. Interpreters must be approved through a separate process the Nebraska Department of Education.

Inservice providers and consultants who provide special education training for parents and staff which directly assist in providing appropriate programs for children with verified disabilities.

Reimbursement:

Service providers must bill the LEA directly for services. The LEA will seek reimbursement for billed services through their AFR 300's and SPEDFRS. 92 51 013.03A

Ward/Residential Treatment Facilities will bill the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services office.

Services

Ward of the State means a child who, as determined by the State where the child resides, is a foster child, is a ward of the State, or is in the custody of a public child welfare agency. Classroom Types through the service provider application

Transition services means a coordinated set of activities for a child with a disability that is designed to be within a results-oriented process that is focused on improving the academic and functional achievement of the child with a disability to facilitate the child's movement from school to post-school activities, including post-secondary education, vocational training, integrated employment, including supported community participation; is based upon the individual child's needs, taking into account the child's strengths, preferences, and interests; and includes instruction, related services, community experiences, the development of employment and other post-school adult living objectives, and when appropriate, acquisition of daily living schools and a functional vocational evaluation. Transition services for children with disabilities may be special education, if provided as a specially designed instruction or related services, if required to assist a child with a disability to benefit from special education.

Level III Special Education Contractual Services means those special education and related services provided in an educational setting not operated by the school district or approved cooperative whose rates are approved by the Nebraska Department of Education. This shall mean special education and related services provided for a period of time exceeding an aggregate of three hours per week.

Court-Ordered/Ward of the State Classroom: General or Special Education Classroom where individuals listed as state wards or court ordered students are placed to receive educational services. Services means those education and related services provided in an educational setting not operated by the school district or approved cooperative whose rates are approved by the Nebraska Department of Education.

Definitions:

Full Timed equivalency (FTE) means the amount of time an individual staff member spends in his or her position assignment as it relates to the total time in the work week defined for that position.

Cost Schedule – costs of a program or services that may include the following:

- a. Salaries and fringe benefits of special education personnel and
- b. Clerical personnel directly associated with the special education services,
- c. Inservice costs related to the special education program,
- d. Instructional equipment Instructional equipment including assistive technology devices and equipment, supplies and publications necessary to aid the child in accomplishing the goals and objectives of the individual education program (IEP) are allowable reimbursable costs under this Chapter. The equipment, supplies, and publications shall be used by the child in association with the implementation of the child's IEP or evaluation. This shall also include equipment, supplies, and publications used by staff when instructing a child with a verified disability; when evaluating a child who is suspected of having a disability; or when reevaluating a child with a verified disability. Allowable and reimbursable costs shall include printing, publication and postage costs that are necessary to carry out the provisions of this Chapter. This shall not include equipment, supplies, and publications used by staff for

- administrative purposes. This shall not include personal equipment and supplies or life support equipment. When equipment is used for purposes other than for special education, the school district or approved cooperative shall only claim the applicable prorated portion for special education payment.
- e. Supervision of special education programs is an allowable expenditure for up to an amount not to exceed 8% of the school district's or approved cooperative's allowable school age program costs, minus the cost of program supervision.
- f. Related services for a child with a verified disability are reimbursable if the services are listed in the IEP and are necessary for the achievement of educational goals as stated in the IEP.
