### **Students**

Your students will access their practice tests and courses through the Student Portal at <https://www.gmetrix.net>. If they do not have an account, they can sign up for a free account on the login page.

Students will need your classroom code that you created to gain access to the content. Once signed in, students will click the key icon on the left side to redeem their access code. This only needs to be done one time and the student will have access until the classroom code expires.

Click "Start a New Test" on the left to begin a practice exam.

Click "Courses" to resume or begin working on curriculum modules.
