Why should schools be concerned?

A student who threatened or attempted suicide is at a far greater risk of another suicide attempt in the weeks immediately following the crisis.

Why is training needed?

Schools often lack clear protocols and staff feel unprepared for supporting a student or colleague returning to school following suicidal behavior.

What will training include?

This training assists staff in knowing what to look for and how to provide support for successful re-entry, including:

- Checklist for developing re-entry procedures
- Safety re-entry plans
- Teacher tips for supporting students
