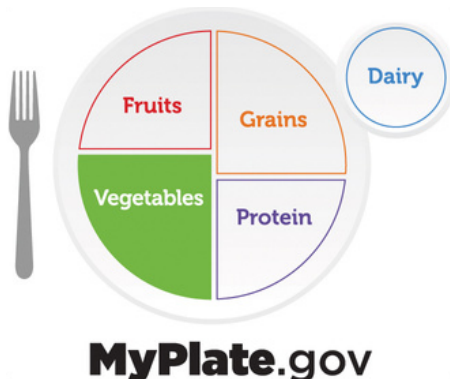


# Broccoli
