


Service Provision Flow

IDENTIFY AND PRIORITIZE PFS

Get the PFS Indicator information from your data specialist.

Use the Pyramid to prioritize PFS students to determine who needs services first and most.




CONDUCT FAMILY NEEDS SCREENER

Meet with the family and conduct a family needs screener.

What does the family need support with at this time?

BEGIN WITH THE END IN MIND

Use what you know about the student's PFS or At-Risk status AND the information gained from your family needs screener to determine which services you want to be able to code for this student as you see them.



PLAN YOUR SERVICES

Identify other agencies, programs, or people that you may need to partner with to serve this student.

Work with the parent and/or school to arrange times to visit with the student.

Provide opportunities for hands-on learning.
