This training is offered especially for school mental health professionals who are new to their position or have not participated in previous NDE suicide prevention trainings. The session will focus on understanding suicide and screening tools to assess suicide risk, as well as supporting students returning to school following a suicide related incident. Opportunities will be provided to explore a wide variety of related resources to utilize in assisting students, staff, and families.

NOTE: A series of refresher trainings will be offered during first semester for review of previous suicide related trainings with updated tools and resources.
