Class Instructions:

1. Gather the class and read "Someday" by Eileen Spinelli. Discuss all the things the young girl plans to be and how she connects to those goals in her daily life as a child.
2. Identify the job titles and required education connected to the today/someday activities in the book E.g. marine biologist who will study dolphins someday and feeds goldfish today, etc.
3. Have students share with a neighbor what they can do as a child to develop their own today/someday skills they will need to achieve their career goals.
4. Have students draw a today/someday picture.
